Procedure

 If the screen resolution is low, choose **More** > **Enterprise** > **Project Management**.
- **Step 3** On the left of the page, click **My Resources**.



- **Step 3** On the left of the page, click **My Resources**.



1.1.3 Filtering Resources

Scenarios

You can enter a search option in the search box provided in the middle of the **My Resources** page to search for your resources.

Supported Filter Criteria

Table 1-1 Supported filter criteria

Filter Criteria	Description	
Name	Enter a name in the search box for a fuzzy search. The resource name is case-insensitive.	

Filter Criteria	Description
Resource ID	Enter a resource ID in the search box for a fuzzy search. The resource ID is case-sensitive.
Tags	If you select Tags as a search criterion, Tag key and Tag value are displayed in sequence, and you need to select a tag key and value.
Enterprise Project	Select an enterprise project from the drop-down list. Resources in the enterprise project are automatically displayed in the resource list.





Scenarios


You can export the information about filtered resources.





Procedure

- **Step 1** Log in to the management console.
- **Step 2** Choose **Enterprise** > **Project Management** in the upper right corner of the page.

 If the screen resolution is low, choose **More** > **Enterprise** > **Project Management**.
- **Step 3** On the left of the page, click **My Resources**.

By default, the **My Resources** page displays the services for which you have resources. To view all the services supported by Config, you can disable **Only display cloud services and regions that contain resources**.




Figure 1-10 My Resources
