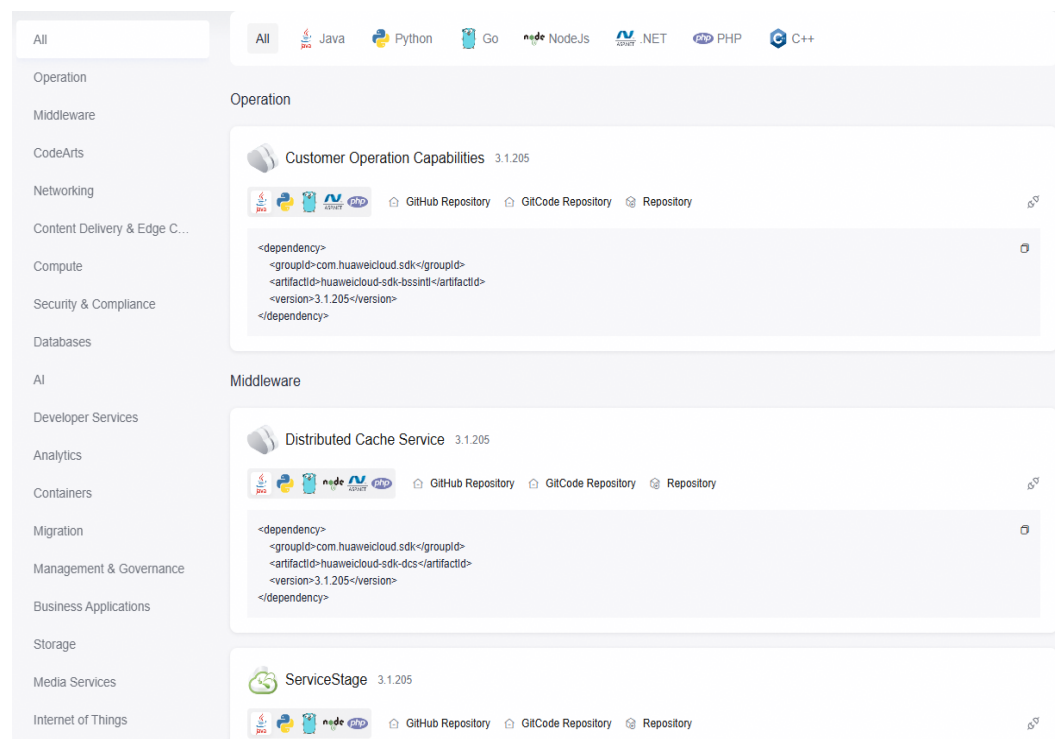

Figure 1-1 SDK Center

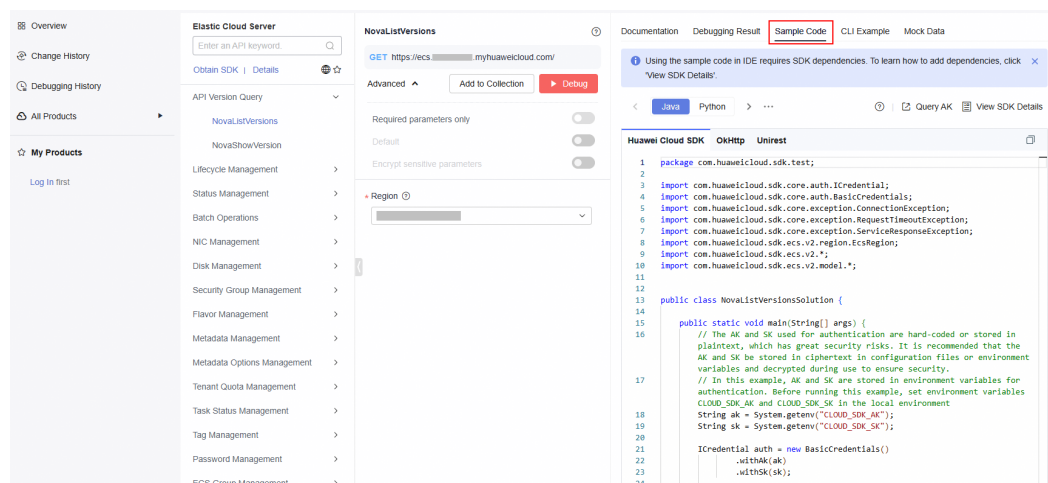


Generating SDK Code Online
