Billing

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1 Billing Description

This section describes the billing items, billing modes, renewals, and arrears policies of CodeArts Agent.

- **Billing modes**

There are monthly and pay-per-use billing modes to meet your requirements.

- The monthly package is available in two editions: basic and professional. This is a prepaid service (pay-before-use) billed based on the purchase cycle of your order. Ensure your account balance is sufficient before purchasing. **Additionally, pay-per-use billing can be enabled.**
- Pay-per-use billing is a postpaid mode. In this mode, you pay for the used tokens.

- **Billing items**

CodeArts Agent is billed based on the number of seats and token usage. For details, see [Billing Items](#).

- **Renewal**

The expiration of a monthly package does not immediately affect the normal use of CodeArts Agent. However, if the retention period is exceeded, resources will be deleted. Renew in time to avoid resource loss. You can renew your subscription manually or automatically. For details, see [Overview](#).

- **Bills**

To learn about your expenditures, go to **Billing Center > Billing**, and check the transactions and bills related to CodeArts Agent. For details, see [Bills](#).

- **Arrears**

Your account goes into arrears when the balance cannot cover the bill you need to pay. To continue using CodeArts Agent, top up your account in time. For details, see [Arrears](#).

- **Billing termination**

To avoid unexpected bills, you can unsubscribe from CodeArts Agent if it is no longer needed. For details, see [Billing Termination](#).

2 Billing Items

Description

Example: Determining Your Billing Period

Assume that you purchased the CodeArts Agent service for one month at 15:50:04 on July 30, 2026 and manually renewed it for another month before it expires. Then:

- The first billing period: July 30, 2026, 15:50:04 to August 30, 2026, 23:59:59
- The second billing period: August 30, 2026, 23:59:59 to September 30, 2026, 23:59:59

3 Billing Modes

3.1 Overview

There are monthly and pay-per-use billing modes to meet your requirements.

- **Monthly Billing:** This is a prepaid billing mode. You pay in advance for a subscription period. It is generally suitable for mature businesses with long-term, stable demand.
- **Pay-per-Use Billing:** This is a postpaid billing mode. You are billed based on the actual token consumption that exceeds the package allowance. The billing unit is per thousand tokens, and fees are settled hourly.

 CAUTION

- **You must purchase a basic or professional edition package before enabling pay-per-use billing.**
- If both monthly subscription and pay-per-use billing are enabled, token consumption is deducted from your package allowance first. Once exhausted, you will be automatically billed at the pay-per-use rate.

The price is calculated according to Model as a Service (MaaS) standards. For supported models and detailed billing rules for MaaS, refer to [prices of preset model services](#).

Table 3-1 lists the differences between the two billing modes.

Table 3-1 Differences between the two billing modes

3.2 Monthly Billing

If you expect to use resources for a longer period, you can save money by selecting the monthly billing. In the monthly billing mode, you can purchase the CodeArts Agent package at discounted prices. This section describes the rules of monthly billing.

Application Scenarios

If you want to ensure resource stability over a certain period of time, monthly billing is a good choice for the following types of workloads:

- Long-term workloads with stable resource requirements, such as official websites, online malls, and blogs
- Long-term projects, such as scientific research projects and projects for large-scale activities. Monthly billing keeps resources available for the entire project lifecycle.

Package Description

CodeArts Agent supports the monthly billing mode and is available in the basic and professional editions, designed to cater to various user scales.

These editions include core features such as code completion and code generation based on comments. Feature sets and token allowances vary by edition. For a detailed comparison, see [Table 3-2](#).

Billing Items

A monthly package is billed based on the number of purchased seats.

Table 3-3 Billing items

Billing Item	Description
Seats	Each account represents one seat.

Billing Cycle

For monthly billing, the billing period is determined by the purchased duration (UTC+8). The billing starts when you activate or renew the subscription and ends at 23:59:59 on the expiration date.

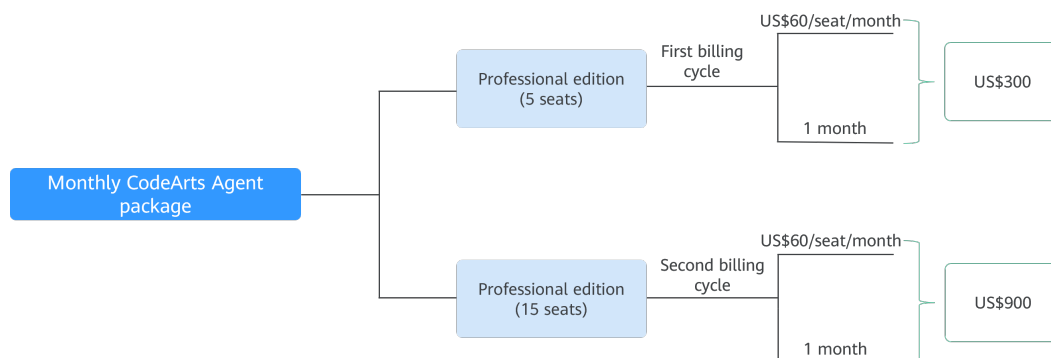
For example, if you purchased the professional edition for one month on July 30, 2026, 15:50:04, the billing cycle is from July 30, 2026, 15:50:04 to August 30, 2026, 23:59:59.

Billing Example

Assume that you purchased a monthly professional edition (5 seats) on July 30, 2026, 15:50:04. Before it expires, you manually renew it for another month and add 10 more seats. Then:

- The first billing period: July 30, 2026, 15:50:04 to August 30, 2026, 23:59:59
- The second billing period: August 30, 2026, 23:59:59 to September 30, 2026, 23:59:59

You must pay in advance for each billing period. [Figure 3-1](#) illustrates the calculation process for the scenario described above. For pricing details, see the purchase page.

Figure 3-1 Monthly billing example

Impact on Billing After Specification Change

If your current package is the basic edition and does not meet your service requirements, you can upgrade it on the [CodeArts Agent](#) console. The system will calculate the change fee based on the following rules:

Price difference = Price for the new specifications × Remaining period – Price for the original specifications × Remaining period

NOTE

The actual price of a CodeArts Agent package is subject to the result displayed on the purchase page.

CodeArts Agent **supports the package upgrade but does not support the package downgrade.**

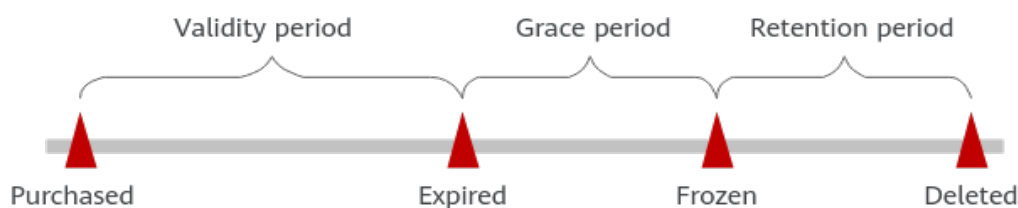
If you need to change the package, see [Modifying Packages](#).

NOTE

To downgrade from a higher tier to a lower tier, unsubscribe from your current active package first, and then purchase the desired lower tier.

Consequences of Expiration

Figure 3-2 illustrates the status of resources included in a CodeArts Agent package at each stage. After purchase, all services are available for normal use within the billing cycle; this stage is the validity period. If the package expires without being renewed, it will successively enter the grace period and retention period.

Figure 3-2 Resource lifecycle of a CodeArts Agent package

Expiration Reminder

Before a monthly package expires, the system will send an expiration reminder through the email address or mobile number you used to create your Huawei Cloud account or through internal messages.

- The system will send you a reminder 15 days, 7 days, 3 days, and 1 day before a monthly package expires.

Consequences of Expiration

When your CodeArts Agent package expires and is not renewed, it goes into the grace period and is in the expired state. During this period, you can still use CodeArts Agent.

If you still do not renew the package within the grace period, your resources will then enter the retention period.

3.3 Pay-per-Use Billing

Pay-per-use billing is a postpaid mode which means you pay nothing up front and are not tied into any contract or commitment. **This section describes the rules of pay-per-use billing.**

For supported models and detailed billing rules for MaaS, refer to [prices of preset model services](#).

Application Scenarios

Pay-per-use billing is ideal for scenarios with high token consumption. **If you have subscribed to the basic or professional package**, your enterprise administrator with [specific permissions](#) can additionally enable pay-per-use billing on the subscription management page. Then, token consumption exceeding the package allowance will be settled on a pay-per-use basis, ensuring uninterrupted access to CodeArts Agent. You can disable pay-per-use billing as needed.

Billing Items

The pay-per-use billing items of CodeArts Agent are as follows:

Table 3-4 Pay-per-use billing items

Billing Item	Description
Tiered billing (by token length of inputs and outputs)	The unit price is determined by model, input token range, and output token range. You can enable pay-per-use billing under Subscriptions on the CodeArts Agent console. The actual price is subject to the result displayed on the purchase page.

Billing Cycle

CodeArts Agent service is billed based on the actual token usage, with fees settled at the top of each natural hour. A new billing cycle begins immediately after settlement. The billing period starts when the pay-per-use mode is enabled for the model and ends when it is disabled.

For example, if you enable the pay-per-use mode for a model at 8:45:30, consume tokens (both input and output), and disable it at 8:55:30, the token usage during this period will be billed to this hourly cycle.

4 Renewal

4.1 Overview

Renewal

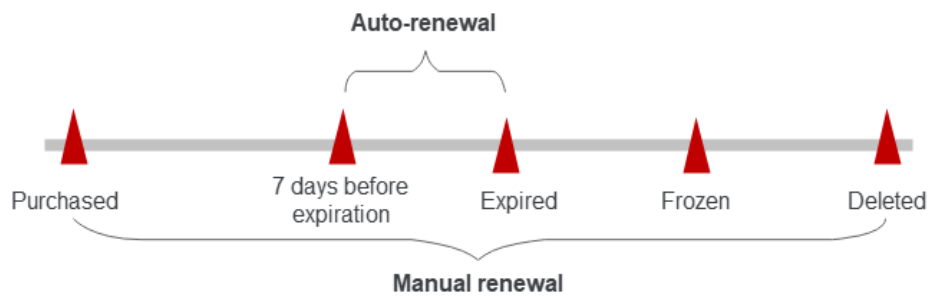
Table 4-1 lists the methods to renew a monthly package.

Table 4-1 Renewal

Method	Description
Manual Renewal	For monthly subscription packages, you can renew at any time under Subscriptions on the CodeArts Agent console before auto-deletion to ensure uninterrupted service.
Auto Renewal	You can enable auto-renewal to automatically renew the CodeArts Agent subscription before it expires. This prevents resources from being deleted in case you forget to renew a subscription.

You can renew your subscription across the lifecycle of your monthly package, as shown in Figure 4-1.

Figure 4-1 Lifecycle of a monthly package



- A monthly package is in the running state from the time when it is purchased to the time when it expires.
- Upon expiration, the package status changes to expired, but you can still use CodeArts Agent.
- If you do not renew your subscription upon expiration, your service enters the grace period. If you still do not renew it after the grace period expires, the package status changes to reserved.
- If you do not renew your subscription after the grace period ends, your service enters the retention period and cannot use CodeArts Agent. If you do not renew the subscription within the retention period, your service will be automatically deleted.

You can enable auto-renewal at any time before a monthly package expires. By default, the system will make the first attempt to charge your account for the renewal at 03:00, seven days before the expiry date. If this attempt fails, it will make another attempt at 03:00 every day until the subscription is renewed or expires. By default, fees are deducted seven days before your subscription expires. You can change this deduction date as required.

4.2 Manual Renewal

For monthly subscription packages, you can renew at any time on the **Renewals** page or under **Subscriptions** on the [CodeArts Agent](#) console before auto-deletion to ensure uninterrupted service.

Renewing on the Console

- Step 1** Log in to the [CodeArts Agent](#) console.
- Step 2** In the navigation pane, choose **Enterprise Management > Subscriptions**.
- Step 3** In the resource list, locate the resource to be renewed and choose **More > Renew** in the **Operation** column.
- Step 4** Select a renewal duration and optionally select **Renew on the standard renewal date**. For details, see [Setting a Fixed Renewal Date for a Monthly Package](#). Confirm the price information and click **Pay**.

NOTE

If you decide to set the package expiration date to the standard renewal date, this may generate additional renewal days that you can check in the **Renewal Duration** column on the renewal page.

- Step 5** Select a payment method and confirm the payment. After you pay the order, the renewal is complete.

Renewing a Subscription in the Billing Center

- Step 1** Go to the [Renewals](#) page.
- Step 2** Set the search criteria.

You can view all resources to be renewed on the **Manual Renewals**, **Auto Renewals**, **Pay-per-Use After Expiration**, and **Renewals Canceled** pages, and manually renew the resources.

All resources that need to be manually renewed can be moved to the **Manual Renewals** tab. For details, see [Enabling Manual Renewal](#).

- Step 3** Manually renew resources. Click **Renew** in the **Operation** column for the desired resource.
- Step 4** Select a renewal duration and optionally select **Renew on the standard renewal date**. For details, see [Setting a Fixed Renewal Date for a Yearly/Monthly Package](#). Confirm the fee and click **Pay**.
- Step 5** Select a payment method and confirm the payment. After you pay the order, the renewal is complete.

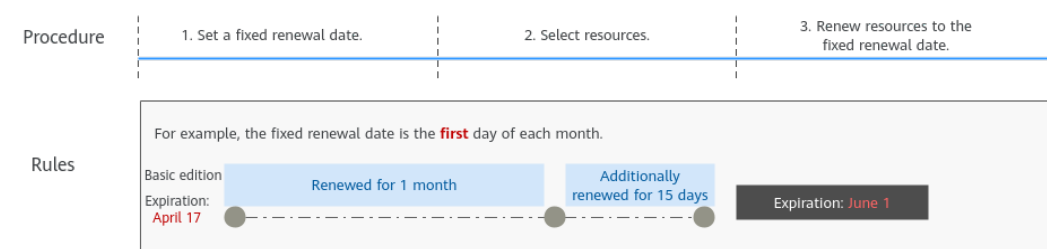
Setting a Fixed Renewal Date for a Monthly Package

Fixed renewal date: The expiration dates are aligned to a certain day of each month for routine management and renewals.

Assume that the expiration date of a basic package is April 17, you renew the subscription for one month, and set the fixed renewal date to the first day of each month. The package will expire on June 1. Actual renewal duration when setting the fixed renewal date = Current renewal duration (1 month) + Duration supplemented till the renewal date (15 days from May 18 to June 1) = 1 month and 15 days.

[Figure 4-2](#) shows the effect of a one-month renewal with a fixed renewal date specified.

Figure 4-2 Setting a fixed renewal date

4.3 Auto Renewal

Auto renewals reduce the management costs of manual renewals. The auto-renewal rules are as follows:

- The first auto-renewal date and billing cycle are calculated based on the expiration date of CodeArts Agent.

- The auto-renewal duration is decided by you. For example, if you select a 3-month renewal duration, your subscription is automatically renewed for three months every time before expiration.
- Auto-renewal can be enabled anytime before a yearly/monthly package expires. The system attempts to automatically renew the package at 03:00 seven days before the service expires. If the fee deduction fails, there will be another attempt at 03:00 every day until the package expires or the renewal is successful.
- After auto-renewal is enabled, you can still renew the package manually if you want to. After a manual renewal is complete, auto-renewal is still valid, and fees start to be deducted seven days before the new subscription expires.
- Fees are deducted seven days before your subscription expires. You can change this deduction date as required.

Prerequisite

Your monthly package has not expired.

Enabling Auto-Renewal During Purchase

You can enable auto-renewal during the purchase of CodeArts Agent, as shown in .

Enabling Auto-Renewal on the Renewals Page

Step 1 Go to the [Renewals](#) page.

Step 2 Set the search criteria.

- On the **Auto Renewals** page, you can check the resources for which auto-renewal has been enabled.
- You can enable auto-renewal for resources on the **Manual Renewals**, **Pay-per-Use After Expiration**, and **Renewals Canceled** pages.

Step 3 Enable auto-renewal for a monthly package.

Select the package for which you want to enable auto-renewal and click **Enable Auto-Renewal** in the **Operation** column.

Step 4 Select a renewal period, specify the desired auto-renewal times, and click **Pay**.

If auto-renewal is enabled on the **Renewals** page, the auto-renewal period is subject to the selected renewal period and auto-renewal times. For example, if you select a three-month renewal period and do not specify the number of renewal times, your subscription is automatically renewed for three months before each expiration.

5 Bills

You can view the bill of a resource in the **Billing** section of Billing Center to learn about its usage and billing information in a certain period.

Bill Reporting Period

After monthly resources are paid, a bill is reported to the billing system.

Checking Bills of a Specific Resource

Step 1 Log in to the [CodeArts Agent](#) console.

Step 2 Copy the resource ID.

1. In the navigation pane, choose **Enterprise Management > Subscriptions**.
2. In the resource list, locate the target resource and copy its ID in the **Product Name/ID** column, as shown in the following figure.

Step 3 Go to **Billing Center > Billing > Bill Details**.

Step 4 Choose **Details**. Select resource ID as a filter, paste the resource ID obtained in [Step 2](#), and press **Enter**.

----End

6 Arrears

Your account goes into arrears when the balance cannot cover the bill you need to pay. Top up your account in time.

Reasons

- You purchased pay-per-use resources when using CodeArts Agent. Your account balance is insufficient to pay for the pay-per-use fees.
- In the case of auto-renewal, your account balance is insufficient to pay for the renewal fees.

Arrears Reminder

Fees are deducted based on pay-per-use resources at the end of each billing cycle. When your account is in arrears, you will be notified by email, SMS, and internal message.

Impact of Arrears

- **Monthly Billing**
This is a pre-paid billing mode, so your monthly package can still be used even if your account is in arrears. However, you cannot perform operations such as modifying packages and renewing orders, because they will generate new expenditures.
- **Pay-per-Use Billing**
If your account is insufficient to pay your amount due, your account goes into arrears and the pay-per-use resources enters the grace period. You need to pay the fees of your pay-per-use resources incurred during the grace period. To view the fees, go to the **Billing Center > Overview** page on the console. Huawei Cloud will deduct the fees after you top up your account.

If you do not bring your account balance current before the grace period ends, the package enters a retention period and its status becomes frozen. You cannot perform any operations on the resources in the retention period.

If you do not bring your account balance current before the retention period ends, your CodeArts Agent resources will be released and the data cannot be restored.

Avoiding and Handling Arrears

If you no longer need pay-per-use billing, disable it to avoid fee deduction.

Configure **Edit Alert Threshold** on the **Billing Center > Overview** page. When the total amount of the available quota, general cash coupons, and flexi-purchase coupons is lower than the threshold, the system automatically notifies you by SMS or email.

7 Billing Termination

Monthly Resources

When you purchase monthly resources, such as a monthly CodeArts Agent package, you make a one-time up-front payment. By default, the billing automatically stops when the purchased subscription expires.

- If you no longer need a resource, but the subscription has not yet expired, you can unsubscribe from a monthly or pay-per-use CodeArts Agent package. Depending on what coupons were used for the purchase, Huawei Cloud may issue you a refund. For details about unsubscription rules, see [Cloud Service Unsubscriptions](#).
- If you have enabled the auto-renewal function, disable it before the auto-renewal deduction date (seven days before the expiration date by default) to avoid unexpected fees. For details, see [Disabling Auto-Renewal](#).

Searching for Resources from Bills and Stopping Billing

To ensure that all billed resources can be found and deleted, obtain the IDs of these resources from the bills, find the specific resources with the IDs, and delete them.

Step 1 Go to **Billing Center > Billing > Billing Details**.

Step 2 Choose **Details**. In the **Resource Name/ID** column, copy the resource ID.

Step 3 Log in to the [CodeArts Agent console](#) and choose **Subscriptions**.

Step 4 In the resource list, locate the target resource based on the value of **Product Name/ID** (resource ID obtained in [Step 2](#)).

If the target CodeArts Agent package is not found, it may have been deleted.

Step 5 In the **Operation** column, choose **More > Unsubscribe** to unsubscribe from the CodeArts Agent package.

Step 6 In the displayed dialog box, confirm and complete the unsubscription as prompted.

If the package is no longer displayed in the resource list, the package has been unsubscribed from.

8 Billing FAQs

8.1 How Are Immediate Change Fees Calculated?

Immediate Change Fee Formula

Immediate change fee = (New package price – Current package price) x
Remaining package duration

Billing Example

Assume that you have purchased a one-month CodeArts Agent basic edition (US \$20/month) on August 1, 2026, 00:00:00, and enabled auto-renewal. The system automatically completes the renewal on August 24, 2026, at 03:00, your billing cycle will be divided into the following two periods:

First billing period (initial validity period): August 1, 2026, 00:00:00 to August 31, 2026, 23:59:59

Second billing period (auto-renewal validity period): September 1, 2026, 00:00:00 to September 30, 2026, 23:59:59

If you initiate an immediate package change on August 25, 2026, 13:40:00 to upgrade to the "professional edition, 1 seat" (US\$60/month), the immediate change fee is calculated as follows:

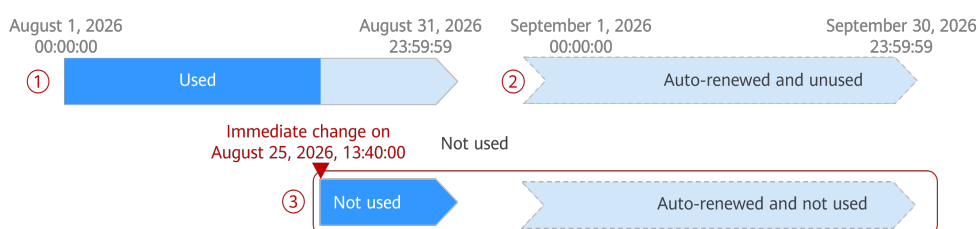
As shown in [Figure 8-1](#), the immediate change fee is calculated in two time frames.

1. Remaining duration in August: 6 days and 10 hours from August 25, 13:40:00 to August 31, 23:59:59. Converted to months, this is approximately 0.20698925 months (6.41666667 days/31 days).
2. Remaining duration in September: one month (the entire September)

The final total fee for the immediate change is: (New package price – Current package price) x Remaining duration = (60 – 20) x (0.20698925 + 1) ≈ US\$ 48.27.

CAUTION

- Remaining duration calculation rules: Upgrades initiated on the purchase date start from 00:00:00 the next day. Upgrades initiated after the purchase date start from the next full hour (or the current hour if upgraded exactly on the hour).
Under these rules, the remaining duration for August in this example should be calculated starting from 2026-08-25, 14:00:00. For details on remaining duration calculation, see [Pricing of Changed Specifications](#).
- The examples in this document are for reference only. The results in these examples are only calculated to two decimal places. When calculating the specification upgrade fee, you are advised to retain at least eight decimal places to ensure consistency between the results calculated and presented.

Figure 8-1 Example timeline for an immediate change

Note: ① indicates the used period, ② the next calendar month, and ③ the remaining available duration after the change.

8.2 Why Has the Package Change Not Taken Effect Immediately?

Question: Why hasn't the new package taken effect immediately after I submitted a package change on the CodeArts Agent console?

Answer: Package changes are categorized into immediate changes and renewal changes, as shown in [Table 8-1](#). If you select **When renewed** for the change type, the new package takes effect only after the current package expires.

Table 8-1 Change types

Change Type	Description
Immediate change	After the change request is submitted, the new package takes effect immediately within the current package duration. Immediate change fee = (New package price – Current package price) x Remaining package duration
Change upon renewal	After the change request is submitted, the new package does not take effect immediately; it automatically takes effect after the validity period of the current package ends.

8.3 What Can I Do If a Message Is Displayed Indicating that the Resource Is Being Processed When I Submit a Package Change Request?

Question: When I submit a package change request on the CodeArts Agent console, message "This resource is currently being processed (e.g., pending renewal or payment). Access Billing Center > Orders > My Orders for details." is displayed. What can I do?

Answer: There are unpaid orders (such as renewal orders) or pending orders. Perform the following steps to locate and rectify the issue:

1. Check whether there are **unpaid orders**.
 - If there are, complete the payment and submit the package change request again. If the error persists, go to **2**.
 - If there are not, go to **2**.
2. Go to the **cloud service unsubscription** page and check whether there are any submitted but pending renewal order.
 - If there is, click **Unsubscribe from Renewal Period** next to it. Once canceled, try submitting the package change request again, and it should proceed normally.
 - If no such orders exist, you can **submit a ticket** through the Huawei Cloud service ticket system to obtain customer service support.

8.4 Can I Continue Using a Package If It Has Not Expired but the Token Quota Is Insufficient?

Question: Can I continue using CodeArts Agent if the package has not expired but the package quota has been used up?

Answer: For the basic or professional edition users whose token quota is exhausted and pay-per-use billing is not enabled, you can continue using CodeArts Agent, but your queue priority will be lowered. To restore higher queue priority, you are advised to enable **pay-per-use billing**.

NOTE

The actual price of a CodeArts Agent package is subject to the result displayed on the purchase page.

8.5 How Are Tokens Consumed If Both Monthly Subscription and Pay-per-Use Billing Are Enabled?

Question: How are tokens consumed if both monthly subscription and pay-per-use billing are enabled?

Answer: The system will first deduct the token quota of the monthly package. After the package quota is completely exhausted, subsequent token consumption will be uniformly calculated and billed in pay-per-use mode.

8.6 Are Token Quota Fees Included in Seats Separately Listed in Bills?

Question: Are token quota fees included in the basic and professional packages separately listed in bills?

Answer: The token fees included in seats are not separately listed in bills, which contain only seat fees.
