Data Lake Visualization (DLV) is a one-stop data visualization platform that adapts to various data sources in the cloud or on-premises. By dragging and dropping 2D and 3D visual components on DLV, you can quickly customize and create a data screen of your own.

DLV allows you to build screens only by drag-and-drop without programming. You can customize the screen size based on the device resolution.

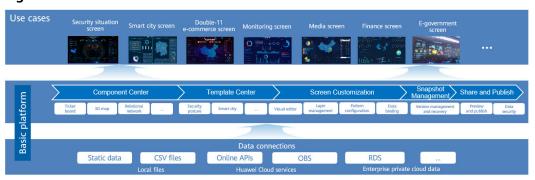
### **Various Data Sources**

DLV can seamlessly integrate with Data Warehouse Service (DWS), Data Lake Insight (DLI), Relational Database Service (RDS), and Object Storage Service (OBS), and supports local CSV files, online APIs, and the private cloud data of enterprises.

DLV presents details about every security incident on screens to help trace all security intrusions, which facilitates security incidents handling of cloud enterprises.

- Access source tracking: Intuitively track security threat sources with 2D and 3D map components.

# **Operation Management Dashboard**

By accessing enterprise operation data, you can obtain information on production status, product quality, and sales status, providing a visualized decision-making basis for enterprise managers.

- Real-time visibility of operational status: The operational status of an enterprise is displayed in a visualized manner in real-time, allowing enterprise managers to stay updated on the current status of the enterprise.

# **Scenario Templates**

DLV provides scenario-based templates to help you quickly design and configure screens that address your specific application requirements. DLV provides the following scenario templates that are continuously updated: Blank Template, Security Situation Awareness, Energy and Chemical Management, Real-Time Monitoring Platform for Cloud Computing-based Industrial Internet, Sales Cockpit, Smart Tourism, Medical Consumables, Order Monitoring, Galaxy Data Monitoring, Data Monitoring Platform, Education Digitalization Distribution, Big Data Platform for Transportation Industry, and Data Center Cloud Monitoring.

#### **Preview**

You can preview screens in real time to learn screen effect whenever you want.

DLV allows you to publish and share your latest or historical version of screens.

# 6 Related Services

### **CDM**

DLV uses Cloud Data Migration (CDM) as a connection agency to access data sources in a Virtual Private Cloud (VPC).

# **Permissions Management**

If you need to assign different permissions to employees in your enterprise to access your DLV resources on the HUAWEI CLOUD, IAM is a good choice for fine-grained permissions management. IAM provides identity authentication, permissions management, and access control, helping you secure access to your HUAWEI CLOUD resources.

With IAM, you can use your HUAWEI CLOUD account to create IAM users, and assign permissions to the users to control their access to specific resources. For example, some software developers in your enterprise need to use DLV resources but should not be allowed to delete the resources or perform any other high-risk operations. In this scenario, you can create IAM users for the software developers and grant them only the permissions required for using DLV resources.

If your HUAWEI CLOUD account does not require individual IAM users for permissions management, skip this section.

IAM can be used free of charge. You pay only for the resources in your account. For more information about IAM, see the IAM Service Overview.

#### **DLV Permissions**

By default, new IAM users do not have permissions assigned. You need to add a user to one or more groups, and attach permissions policies or roles to these groups. Users inherit permissions from the groups to which they are added and can perform specified operations on cloud services based on the permissions.

DLV is a project-level service deployed and accessed in specific physical regions. To assign DLV permissions to a user group, specify the scope as region-specific projects and select projects (for example, ap-southeast-1 in CN-Hong Kong) for the permissions to take effect. If **All projects** is selected, the permissions will take effect for the user group in all region-specific projects. When accessing DLV, the users need to switch to a region where they have been authorized to use this service.

You can grant users permissions by using roles and policies.

• Roles: A type of coarse-grained authorization mechanism that defines permissions related to user responsibilities. This mechanism provides only a limited number of service-level roles for authorization. When using roles to grant permissions, you need to also assign other roles on which the

permissions depend to take effect. However, roles are not an ideal choice for fine-grained authorization and secure access control.

DLV does not provide IAM role-based permission control.

Policies: A type of fine-grained authorization mechanism that defines
permissions required to perform operations on specific cloud resources under
certain conditions. This mechanism allows for more flexible policy-based
authorization, meeting requirements for secure access control. For example,
you can grant ECS users only the permissions for managing a certain type of
ECSs.

Most policies define permissions based on APIs. Fine-grained access control of DLV is based on workspace roles. Users can associate roles with permissions to meet different authorization requirements. For details about how to grant the DLV role, see **Creating Users and Granting DLV Permissions**.

**DLV Roles and Permissions** lists the common operations supported by each system-defined policy or role of DLV. Select the policies or roles as required.

DLV does not strongly depend on any services. However, DLV supports multiple cloud services as data sources. To use the data sources, you need to have system permissions of the related cloud services. When configuring permissions for the DLV user group, you need to select the system policies and system roles of related cloud services in the same project. **Table 7-2** describes the system permissions of the cloud services on which DLV depends. When configuring permissions for DLV users, grant permissions as follows:

- If policy-based access control has been enabled, select the system policies of the services on which the policy-based access control depends in the same project. If the services on which the policy-based access control depends do not have system policies, select the system roles of the services.
- If policy-based access control is not enabled, select the system roles of the required services in the same project.

#### **Ⅲ** NOTE

- HUAWEI CLOUD accounts or the users with the **DLV FullAccess** permission can perform all operations on DLV by default.
- Only the users with the **DLV FullAccess** or **Tenant Administrator** permission can purchase DLV packages, create, delete, and modify workspaces, and set the default workspace.

The **Tenant Administrator** permission has all cloud service administrator permissions except the IAM management permission. For security purposes, you are not advised to grant this permission to IAM users. Exercise caution when performing this operation.

- By default, the HUAWEI CLOUD account has permission to add workspace members. If a sub-user of an account needs to add workspace members, the account needs to grant the required permissions to the sub-user. Only the following three types of sub-user have permission to add workspace members:
  - User who is assigned the DLV workspace administrator role and has the IAM ReadOnlyAccess permission
  - User who has the **DLV FullAccess** permission
  - User whose has the **Tenant Administrator** permission

To grant the preceding permissions to a sub-user, log in to the IAM console, create a user group, grant the required permissions to the user group, and add the sub-user to the user group.

# 8 Billing

DLV is free for use during open beta test (OBT).

Before using DLV, be aware of the following use restrictions:

- DLV can be used only on PCs. Compatibility with other terminals are not ensured.
- The supported browser types and versions are listed as follows:
  - Google Chrome 59 or later
- DLV does not support CDM (2.9 or later) as the network proxy.

# **10** Basic Concepts

## **Regions and AZs**

For more information, see Regions and AZs.

## **Project**

A project is a collection of resources and a minimum authorization unit. Users' resources must be mounted to a project. Projects are used to isolate resources between different departments, different projects, or different environments, such as the R&D environment, test environment, and production environment, in the same project.

# Workspace

A workspace enables the administrator to manage user (member) permissions, resources, and underlying compute engines of DLV.

Each team can have an independent workspace.

You can manage workspaces, data connections, screens, combined screens, and applications only after being added to workspaces and assigned permissions.

In workspace management, the administrator can add other users to the workspace and set roles such as administrator, developer, analyst, and visitor preset by DLV for users to implement multi-role collaborative development.

#### Member and Role

A member is a user who has been granted permission to access or use the workspace created on Huawei Cloud. When adding a workspace member, you need to set a role.

A role has a predefined combination of permissions. Different roles are assigned different permissions. After a role is assigned to a member, the member has all the permissions of that role. Each member must have at least one role, but they can have multiple roles assigned at the same time.

A workspace role can be an administrator, developer, analyst, or visitor.

#### **Data Source**

A data source is where data comes from. DLV provides multiple types of data connection: static data, APIs, databases, CSV files, APIG, and OBS.

## Component

A component is a basic configurable module used to create a screen. DLV supports the following types of components: regular charts, maps, media, text, relational networks, materials, interaction, and others.

#### **Canvas**

A canvas is an interface editor used to edit components of DLV. On a canvas, you can design page layout and match colors for components and associate data sources with charts. All applications are published only in the canvas.

## Layer

A layer refers to the precise positioning of a component on a screen. It is similar to a slide that contains elements such as text or graphics and is then combined with other slides in sequence to produce the final effect of a page.
