Serverless Video Transcoding

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Solution Overview


Scenarios

This solution uses a FunctionGraph Object Storage Service (OBS) trigger to transcode video files in an OBS bucket. The transcoding parameters are configured using environment variables. This solution depends on the third-party library ffmpeg for automatic transcoding, reducing labor costs.

Solution Architecture

This solution uses FunctionGraph to transcode video files uploaded to an OBS bucket. This solution architecture is illustrated below.

Figure 1-1 Architecture



This solution will:

• Create two OBS buckets for storing original and transcoded video files, respectively.

- Create an agency in Identity and Access Management (IAM) to delegate FunctionGraph to access video files uploaded to an OBS bucket.
- Create a video transcoding function and an OBS trigger in FunctionGraph.

Advantages

- Ease of use
 - The serverless architecture frees you from resource O&M to focus on services.
- Low cost
 - You pay only for what you use.
- Easy deployment
 You can configure FunctionGraph and OBS resources in just a few clicks.

Constraints

- Before deploying this solution, ensure that you have an account with access to the target region and sufficient balance for purchasing the resources listed in 2 Resource and Cost Planning.
- Ensure that OBS buckets are empty before deleting them.

3.1 Preparations

Creating the rf_admin_trust Agency

Step 1 Log in to Huawei Cloud official website, open the **console**, hover over the account name, and choose **Identity and Access Management**.

Figure 3-1 Console page






Figure 3-2 Identity and Access Management


Step 2 Choose **Agencies** in the left navigation pane and search for the **rf_admin_trust** agency.

Figure 3-3 Agency list



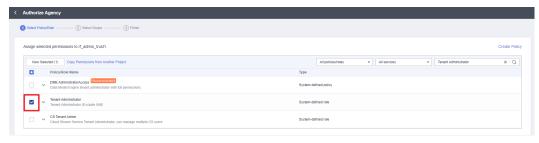
- If the agency is found, skip the following steps.

- Step 3 Click Create Agency in the upper right corner of the page. On the displayed page, enter rf_admin_trust for Agency Name, select Cloud service for Agency Type, select RFS for Cloud Service, and click Next.

Figure 3-4 Creating an agency




Step 4 Search for **Tenant Administrator**, select it in the search results, and click **Next**.







Figure 3-13 Agency list









Figure 3-17 Selecting a solution










Step 1 Go to the **FunctionGraph console**, and view the created function in the function list.

- **Object Storage Service (OBS)**: OBS provides stable, secure, efficient, and easy-to-use cloud storage that lets you store virtually any volume of unstructured data in any format and access it from anywhere using REST APIs.
- FunctionGraph: FunctionGraph allows you to run your code without
 provisioning or managing servers, while ensuring high availability and
 scalability. All you need to do is upload your code and set execution
 conditions, and FunctionGraph will take care of the rest. You pay only for
 what you use and you are not charged when your code is not running.
- **Identity and Access Management (IAM)**: IAM enables you to easily manage users and control their access to Huawei Cloud services and resources.
