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# 1 Applying for an OBT

This section describes how to apply for OBTs for products and services.

## Procedure


The following uses SSL Certificate Service as an example to describe how to apply for an open beta test (OBT).

**Step 1** Log in to the [HUAWEI CLOUD](#) homepage.

**Step 2** In the drop-down list box of the current logged-in account, choose **Console**.


The Console page is displayed.

**Step 3** Select a resource you want to apply for an OBT.



The resource console is displayed.

**Step 4** Click **Create Now**.



**Step 5** Set information as required, including the enterprise scale, R&D personnel proportion, application scenario, and current service phase.

 **NOTE**

When applying for an OBT for a product the second time, you can inherit the mandatory information you entered for the same product last time.

**Step 6** Select **Agree *OBT Trial Service Agreement***.

**Step 7** Click **Apply For The Beta**.

Click **Go to Open Beta Tests**, showing the products or services for which you have applied for OBTs.



# 2 My Resources

This topic describes how to view resources and perform related operations.

## Procedure

- Step 1** Log in to the [HUAWEI CLOUD](#) homepage.
- Step 2** On the displayed page, click **Console** in the upper right corner.  
The **Console** page is displayed.
- Step 3** Choose **Resources > My Resources**.



- Viewing purchased resources: You can select **Only list services with available resources** and select a region to view the resources purchased in the region under your account.
- Purchasing cloud services: You can select a region and click any cloud service in the region. The page for purchasing that cloud service is displayed.

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# 3 My Quotas

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## What Is the Quota?

Quotas are enforced for service resources on the platform to prevent unforeseen spikes in resource usage. Quotas can limit the number of resources available to users, such as the maximum number of ECSs or EVS disks that can be created.

If the existing resource quota cannot meet your requirements, you can apply for a higher quota.


To view service quotas, IAM users must have Tenant Guest or Tenant Administrator permissions.

## How Do I View My Quotas?

**Step 1** Log in to the [HUAWEI CLOUD](#) homepage.


**Step 2** On the displayed page, click **Console** in the upper right corner.

The **Console** page is displayed.

**Step 3** Click  in the upper left corner and select the desired region and project.

**Step 4** In the upper right corner of the page, choose **Resources > My Quotas**.

The **Service Quota** page is displayed.



**Step 5** View the used and total quota of each resource type.


If a quota cannot meet service requirements, click **Increase Quota** in the upper right corner.

## How Do I Increase a Quota?

1. Log in to the management console.
2. In the upper right corner of the page, choose **Resources > My Quotas**.

The **Service Quota** page is displayed.



3. Click **Increase Quota**.
4. On the **Create Service Ticket** page, configure parameters as required.  
In the **Problem Description** area, enter your required quota and reason for the adjustment.
5. After all necessary parameters are configured, select the customer agreement and click **Submit**.
